1. Designation of the data acquisition and processing activity

Information for user registration is collected only via the questionnaire, which is part of the License Terms and Conditions for Use of Software for Precise Orbit and Clock Combination (SPOCC). The user sends the filled-out and signed License Terms and Conditions document to GFZ via email during the registration process.

3. Purposes and legal bases of the processing of personal data

Purpose:

Personal data are collected to verify the registration.

Legal bases:

Art. 6 no. 1 lit. f GDPR serves as the legal basis when processing is necessary to safeguard the legitimate interests of the GFZ, provided these legitimate interests are not outweighed by the data subject's interests and fundamental rights and freedoms. The legitimate interest is the software licensing.

5. Origin and categories of personal data processed

Personal data provided by the user during the registration process: name, email address, git user name, entity

6. Transfer of personal data to a third country

Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country or an international organization.

7. Duration of storage of personal data

Personal data are stored until termination of the related license as defined under point 6 of the License Terms and Conditions document.

8. Rights of data subjects

Every data subject has the right to:

- a. Information in accordance with Art. 15 DSGVO,
- b. Rectification pursuant to Art. 16 DSGVO,
- c. Erasure in accordance with Art. 17 DSGVO,
- d. Restriction of processing in accordance with Art. 18 DSGVO
- e. Data portability pursuant to Art. 20 DSGVO
- f. Right of object pursuant to Art. 21 DSGVO.

The restrictions under §§ 34 and 35 BDSG apply to the right to information and the right to erasure.

In addition, there is a right of appeal to a data protection supervisory authority (Art.13 Abs. 2 lit. d i.V.m. Art. 14 Abs. 2 lit. D DSGVO, Art. 77 DSGVO i.V.m. § 19 BDSG).
